## Annual Registration Fee

Each Dakota Gold member is required to pay an annual registration fee of \$38.00/child or \$50.00/family. Registration fees are used to offset the cost of liability insurance. This annual fee is due every September. **This is a non-refundable fee.**

- **Payment: Automatic Withdrawal (ACH) only out of checking or savings Once a month (on the 1st), 4 mths(Sept-Dec or Jan-May) or full 9 months(Sept-May)**
- **(Waive your registration fee by signing up for 12 month ACH run. Registration needs to be done in our office along with membership fee at that time in order to secure spot.)**
- All paid in full memberships are non-refundable.
- Gymnasts must wear a leotard or one-piece swimsuit. Biker shorts worn over or under a leotard are allowed.
- Gymnastics students may "make up" class they miss as long as it is during the month of the class they miss. **Please contact office staff for appropriate time.**

## Parent Tots (18mons-2 ½)

Interactive parent child, fun, Developmental girls or boys, beginning gymnastics.

## Boys Ninja (5 years-9 years)

Our boys ninja program is a high energy filled class with obstacle course, tumbling, some martial arts moves which will help develop strength and speed.

## Tumble Tots (3-pre-school)

This class is for boys and girls and is designed to help with developing high level motor skills, social/listening and self a steam all while learning the basic fundamentals of gymnastics! Must be potty trained.

## Gymnastics I (kindergarten-2nd grade)
